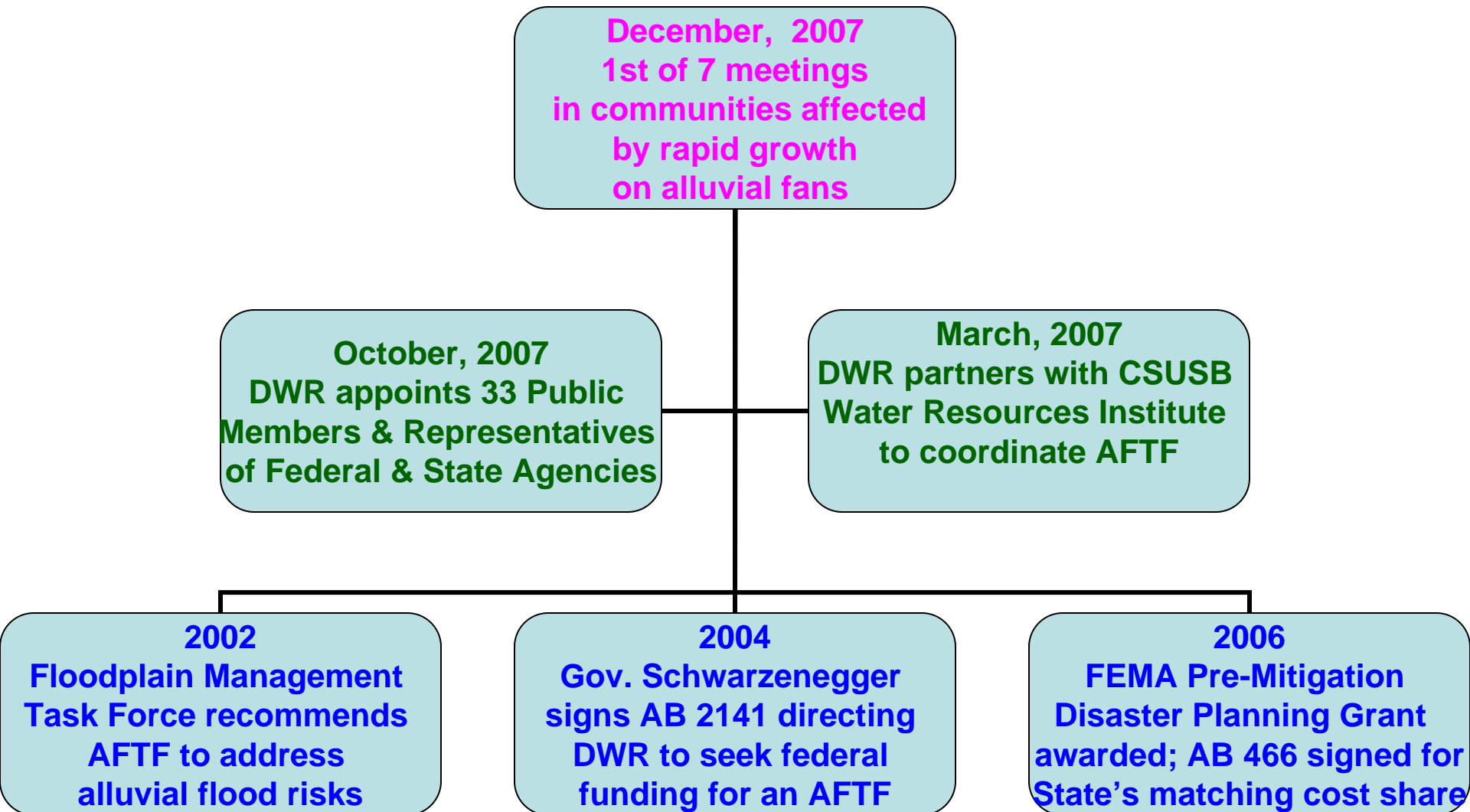

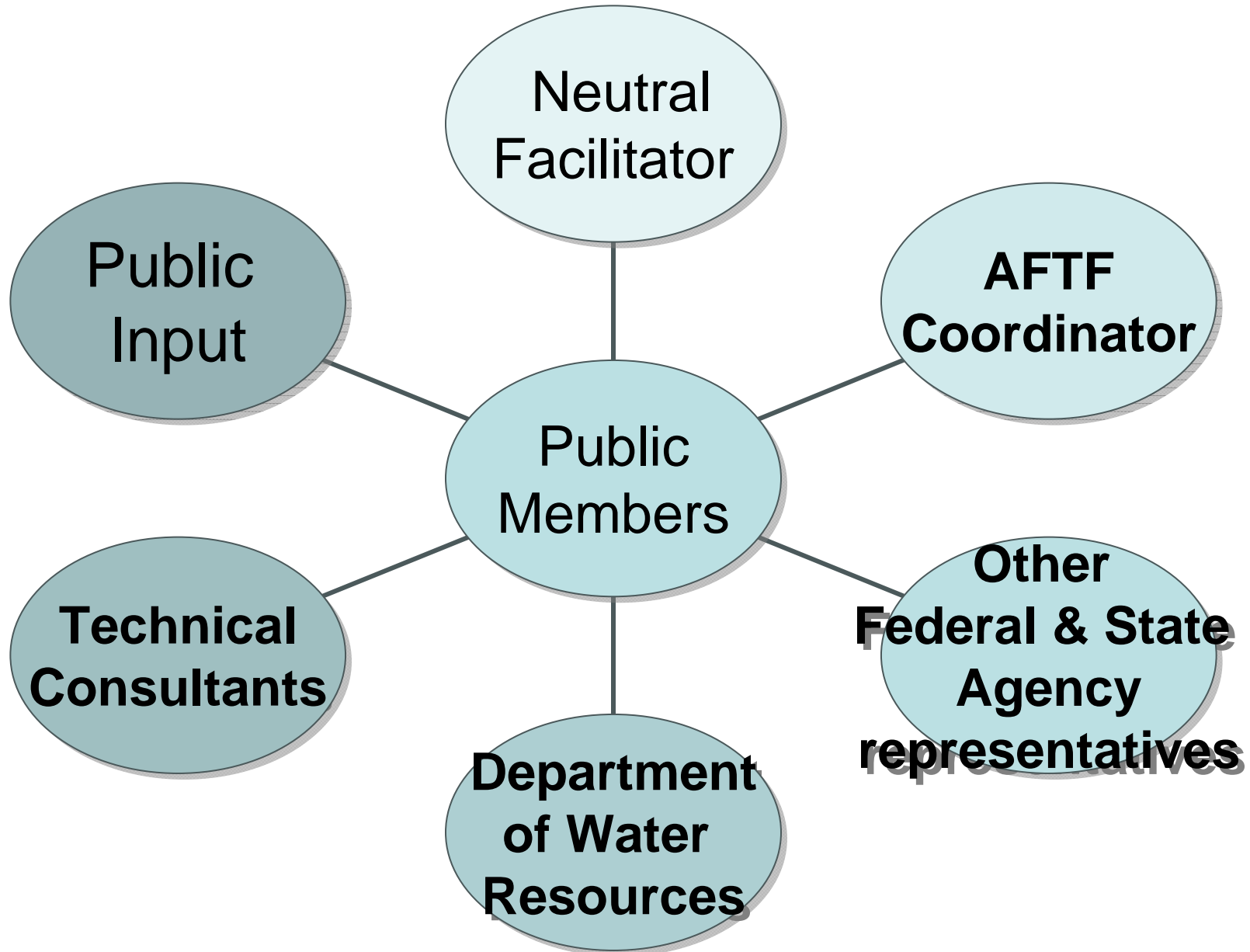
Mission of AFTF
